Our Story

'Education For All' is a rural outreach program to provide quality education free of charge to children from all walks of life irrespective of cast, creed, religion or any other background. At present we have tied up with Prashanthi Bala Mandir Trust (www.pbmt.org) to provide support in sponsoring children and help in construction and maintenance of Schools. Currently we are helping in the construction of SSS Karunyanikethanam school for boys in Tumkur near Bengaluru, India along with sponsoring children.

Status of the school

- **Plan:** The school will be spread over 40 Acres of land with total built up area of about 120,000 Sq Ft
- **Land Purchased:** October 2017
- **Construction started:** March 2018
- **Temporary structure inauguration:** June 2018
- **First batch admitted:** June 2018
- **Second batch admitted:** June 2019
- **Under construction:** Hostel building and class rooms

Unique Features of this school

- **Free Education** for all students. Currently, this campus has a total strength of 102 students studying in 6th and 7th grades (Kannada medium and English medium)
- **Residential School:** Hostel fees are exempted for financially challenged parents. Most of the children enrolled in the school hail from under-privileged sections of India.
- **Each one educate one:** Self-sustaining model of quality education through support and involvement of alumni, local communities, and society.
- **Highly-nourishing food** and well-designed dormitory facilities. Digital education, environmental education, sports, community service projects and personal spiritual development
- All campuses are designed to be “Green” with a focus on using solar energy-based power supply, water conservation, tree planting and similar environmental initiatives.
- **The 3H formula:** Empowering the Head, heart, and hands. Holistic education that nurtures a child’s physical, intellectual, emotional, and spiritual well being.
- **A harmonious atmosphere** where children celebrate diversity of faiths, and develop mutual respect and love through community service and self reliance activities.
